UPON THE Claimants having applied for permission to seek judicial review of the Defendant's decision to exercise the power in s.222 of the Local Government Act 1972 to apply to renew the St Andrews Ward injunction order and/or its implementation of that order

AND UPON the Defendant having applied to the County Court to discharge the s.222 injunction order and upon that application being granted on 22 May 2020 such that the injunction has been discharged

AND UPON the Defendant agreeing that in developing its future strategic policy with respect to on-street workers it will (i) consult the Claimants; (ii) work with other agencies including Humberside Constabulary, the Police and Crime Commissioner and National Ugly Mugs; and (iii) ensure that it complies with its public sector equality duty pursuant to s.149 of the Equality Act 2020

AND UPON the Defendant agreeing to pay the Claimant's costs in these proceedings in the sum of £40,000 inclusive of VAT within 28 days of the date of this order
